
INSTALLATION


This fixture is to be mounted to an anchored junction box or in-ground mounting spike.

- 1. Verify that power is OFF.
- 2. Feed wire leads from fixture through Locknut and junction box/ground spike Cover.
- 3. Thread Locknut fully onto Knuckle base, then thread Knuckle into Cover.
- 4. Aim fixture and tighten Locknut against Cover. [If equipped with the Sure-Aim rotation accessory, apply theadlocking agent (by others) to threads and install fixture until it bottoms out onto Cover. After installation is complete, loosen set screw nearest the Cover with a 5/32" hex wrench to rotate fixture to desired position.]
- 5. Use silicone-filled wire nuts to join fixture wires and wires from power source as shown in the diagram: black lead connects to hot, white to neutral, and green to ground. Use silicone or electrical tape around the wire nuts to ensure proper connection.
- 6. Push connections into junction box or ground spike and attach Cover.
- 7. Angle the fixture head to desired position. Tighten Knuckle with a 5/32" hex wrench.

RELAMPING

- 1. Unscrew Housing from Base by turning it counterclockwise. (Lens/Endcap assembly is permanently attached to the Housing—do not attempt to unscrew.)
- 2. Hold Lamp at its base and rotate it about 1/4 turn counter-clockwise. Pull up to remove.
- 3. Insert pins of new Lamp into Socket and turn clockwise until it stops.
- Screw Housing back onto fixture base.
